The aim of our Post 16 Curriculum is to introduce students to the concept of legal liability through the study of criminal law and the law of tort. Learners will be required to show knowledge and understanding of the nature of law and the English legal system.

Students will take part in various law related activities including a Shakespeare on Trial workshop at The Royal Courts of Justice. The workshop is run in conjunction with Brunel University and will enable students to refine their understanding of the court hierarchy and the important roles within the legal profession.
